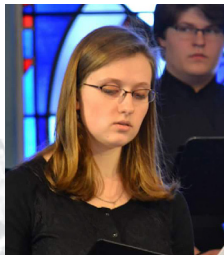

Haiti: Thanks to you, children now have a classroom to study in!

Your support allowed a group of volunteers to build a schoolroom in Jacmel



Thanks to generous donors like you, a group of eight volunteers went to Jacmel to build school furniture and a classroom for students of the school at the St. Augustine parish in Jacmel.

Nearly every ROCOR parish in Haiti has a school for kids from toddlers to 6th grade – not only for the children of the parishioners, but for anyone in need.



“If it hadn’t been for these schools, some of these kids would have been living on the streets,” said Archpriest Alexandr Antchoutine, who visited Haiti with the group.

Thanks to kind people like you, the children at the St. Augustine school now have a roof over their heads when they come to classes. They no longer study in a tent. Thank you!

5 WAYS YOU HELPED HAITI THIS YEAR:

1. Built a classroom for school children in Jacmel

Your generosity allowed a group of volunteers to travel to Haiti and help the St. Augustine parish with a difficult construction project.

2. Provided food and clothing to students in ROCOR parish schools

Nearly every ROCOR parish has a school for kids from toddlers to 6th grade. They not only provide free education, but also feed them lunch (it is the only daily meal some kids are sure to have), and provide them with uniforms, so the destitute can come to school, even if they do not have any clothes.

3. Gave much-needed moral support to mission members

Very few Orthodox Christians visit mission members. Sometimes they feel very far away from the rest of the Orthodox world. When a group of volunteers headed by the First Hierarch, His Eminence Metropolitan Hilarion came to pray and to provide fellowship with the local mission, they were truly happy.

4. Sponsored clergy to serve their flock

Hundreds of parishioners depend on our clergy in Haiti. Every day someone comes to them for help: be it with advice, a chore, or to borrow food. If it hadn't been for your assistance, the highly-educated priests would have probably be forced to set up vegetable booths at the local market to make a living.

5. Took care of the missions' most vulnerable members

You allowed mission members to take care of the mentally and physically disabled in their community. Thanks to donors like you, they are slowly turning the tide of prejudice against the disabled.

*Their situation was desperate,
but you helped*

Recently we wrote to you about Matushka Hanna, whose work allowed her husband Fr. Demetrio to serve his parish full-time... until she got cancer.

Fr. Demetrio has devoted two years of his life and all of his considerable energy to serving for free as a chaplain and teacher at the St Luke the Blessed Surgeon chapel at the Paideia Classical Academy in Coconut Creek, FL.

This is a school that accepts any children, not just the Orthodox, and teaches them according to the doctrine of our Church. Many teachers either work on a much-reduced salary, or volunteer their time completely like Fr. Demetrio.

The small chapel, where Fr. Demetrio serves, had only six parishioners when he first started serving there. Today they have around 25 people on Sundays.

Fr. Demetrio's wife, matushka Hanna, was the family's only provider, as she encouraged Fr. Demetrio to devote all his time and energy to the service of God and His Church. But a few months ago, she was diagnosed with cancer.
